The Episcopal Church of the Epiphany believes that photos, videos, and other media play a valuable role in creating connections within our faith community and in helping it flourish and grow. During the first 6 months of the pandemic, our worship and meetings via Zoom were our only means of connection. Then and now, photos and videos tell our story, provide visitors information and an idea of what to expect when they attend, highlight the work of those who serve, and allow us to better communicate our mission within and outside our parish.

Accordingly, photography, videography, and live streaming may be in progress at Epiphany's worship services, classes, and other church events. Church of the Epiphany may use the media recorded at these events in materials produced by or for the church, including but not limited to our bulletins, posters, brochures, newsletters and other printed and electronic materials and digital media (such as our website, Facebook, Instagram, Zoom, YouTube).

By participating in Church of the Epiphany's liturgies, classes, and other events, you consent to be photographed, videotaped or otherwise recorded; you grant your permission for Epiphany to use recordings containing your image, likeness, voice or statements, without compensation, credit or other consideration to you, for Epiphany's promotional, publicity and other purposes; and you agree to release, hold harmless and indemnify Church of the Epiphany from any liability involving the use of your image, likeness, voice or statements. If you prefer to sit in a location where you will be less visible to the camera, please let an usher, clergy, or staff person know.
