

**Episcopal Church of the Epiphany
Annual Parish Meeting
January 24, 2026**

Due to inclement weather, the Annual Parish Meeting was held via Zoom. Amy Dills-Wright opened the meeting with a prayer. She then appointed Sherry Wallace to be Secretary for the meeting.

Pam Tipton, Chair of the Stewardship Committee, stated that we have exceeded our pledge goal for next year and thanked the parish for our willingness to contribute to caring for our neighbors. She also thanked those who shared their stories with the parish during the pledge drive.

Amy next recognized and thanked Randy Shearin, Treasurer, who then gave the financial report. He shared the 2026 budget as it stood before the latest pledges were received this month. He noted that this is the first year we will have funds from the new Enduring Light Fund.
