Dear Epiphanyites,

Our collect this week for the twentieth Sunday after Pentecost begins, “Lord, we pray that your grace may always precede and follow us, that we may continually be given to good works.” Our awareness of God’s grace ahead and behind us, upholding us at every turn, inspired our Stewardship theme for this year: Grace, Gratitude, and Giving.
